Disaster Home Repair Assistance

If you do not have homeowner's insurance and/or did not receive enough funds from FEMA to pay for home repairs, there is possible Disaster Home Repair Assistance for eligible households available through the S.H.I.P. program.

Guidelines:

- Owner Occupied properties only rental properties are not eligible.
- Mobile homes are eligible but must be 1994 or newer.
- Funds are limited and each application will be reviewed to determine priority.
- Household eligibility is based on the number of household members and the gross household income. See income limits chart below:
